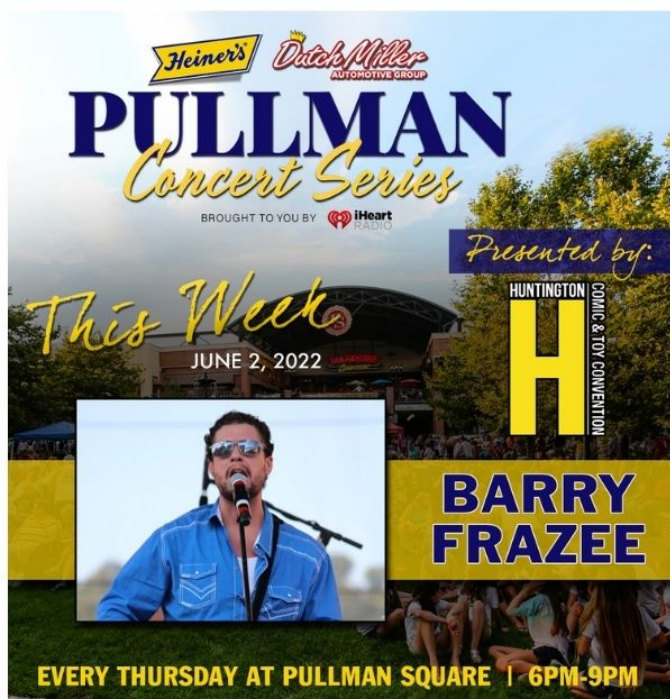

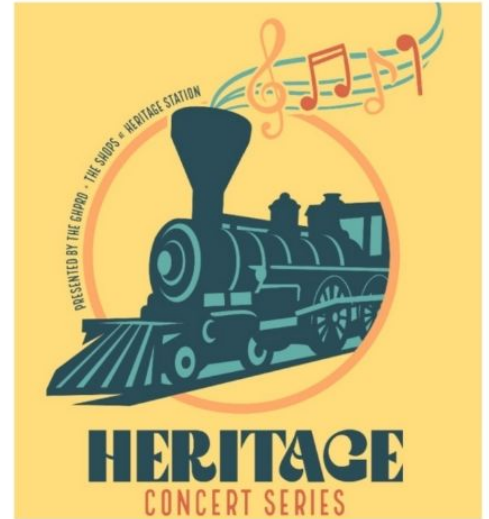

June 11 | Ritter Park

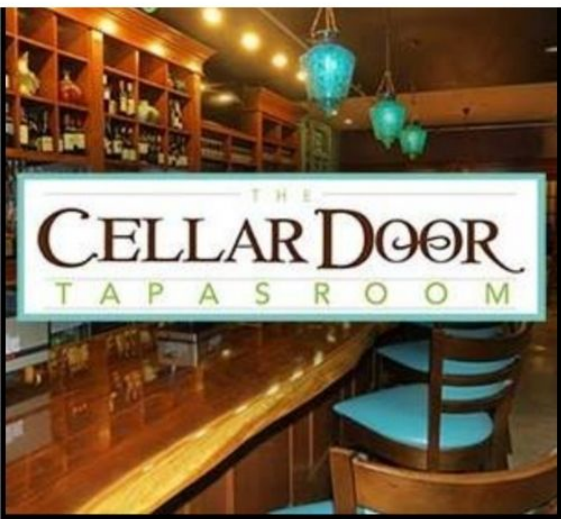

June 17 | Ritter Park Fountain

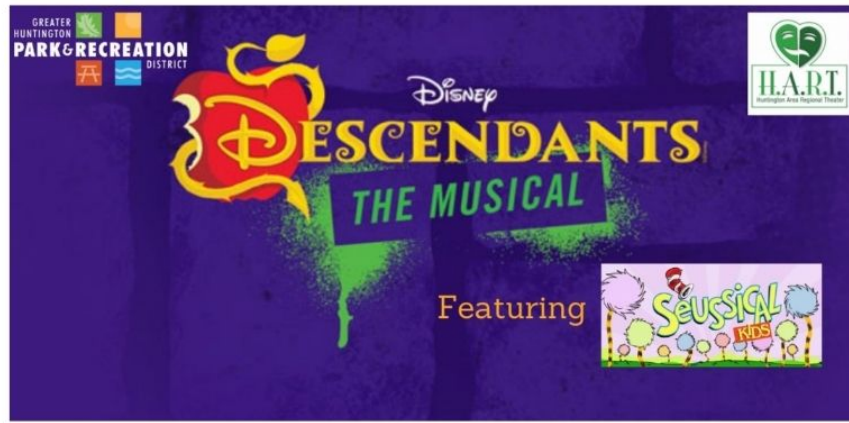

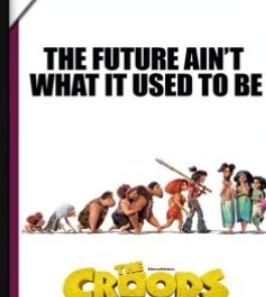
